

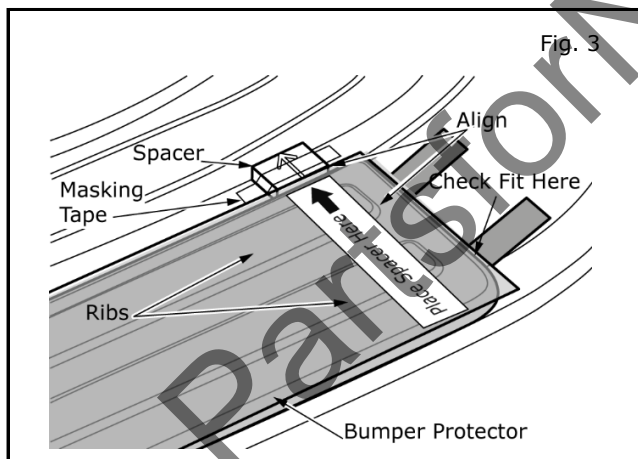
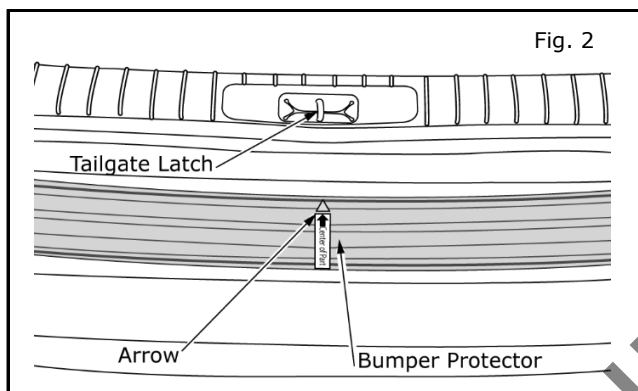
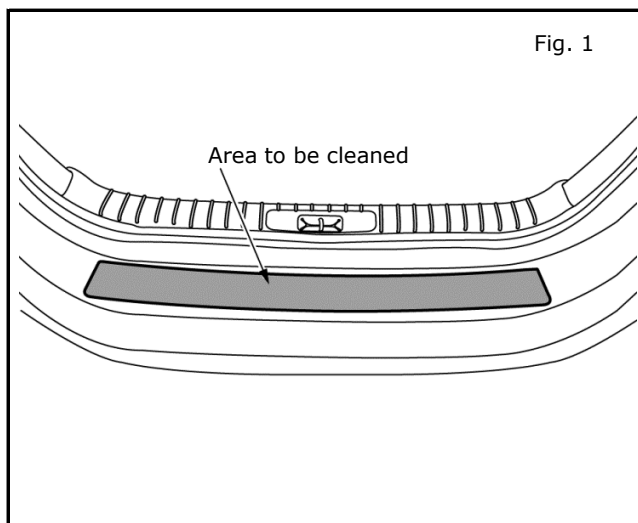

<div>⚠ CAUTION</div> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Install the rear bumper protector only when the part & vehicle temperatures are between 60°F-110°F (16°C-43°C).• Do not wash or expose the vehicle to a wet environment for 24 hours after installing the rear bumper protector.																	

Installation Procedure:



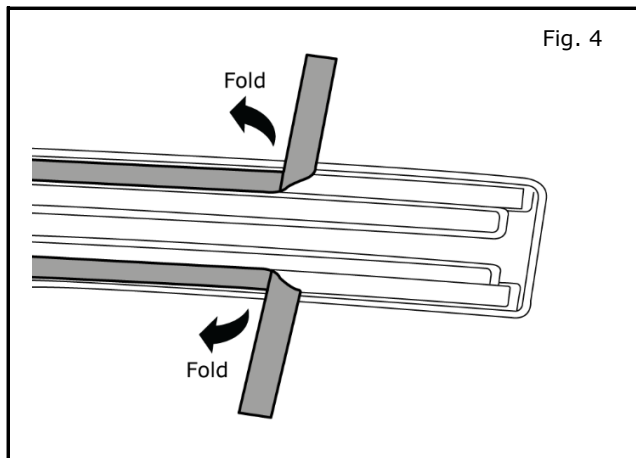
- 1) Clean vehicle area thoroughly with soap and water to remove any dirt or debris and allow to dry.
- 2) Bumper protector installation prep.
 - a) Open rear hatch
 - b) Using a clean lint-free cloth and 90% Isopropyl Alcohol prep pads, clean area of rear bumper where part will be installed.
 - c) Allow time to dry thoroughly.

CAUTION

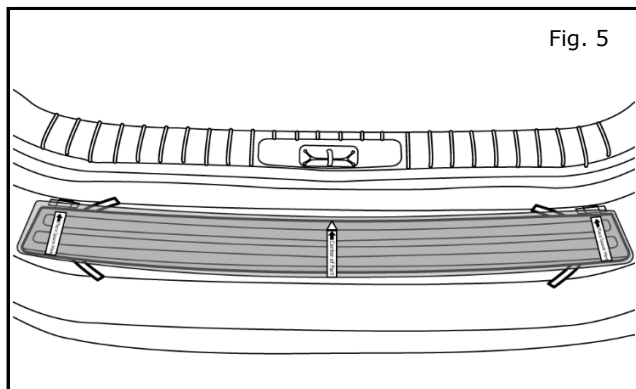
- Failure to clean mounting surface properly may cause adhesive tape to have poor adhesion to vehicle.

- 3) Dry fit bumper protector on vehicle by aligning bumper protector centering arrow with tailgate latch.
- 4) Position spacer block so that edge of block is approximately in line with ends of ribs on bumper protector and arrow points toward front of vehicle.
- 5) Secure spacer block to bumper with masking tape.

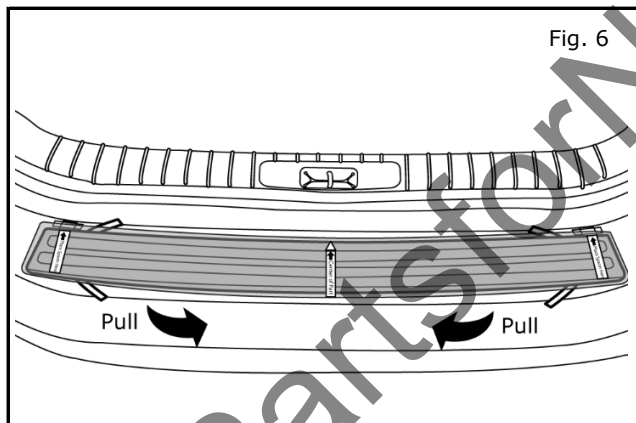
Installation Procedure:



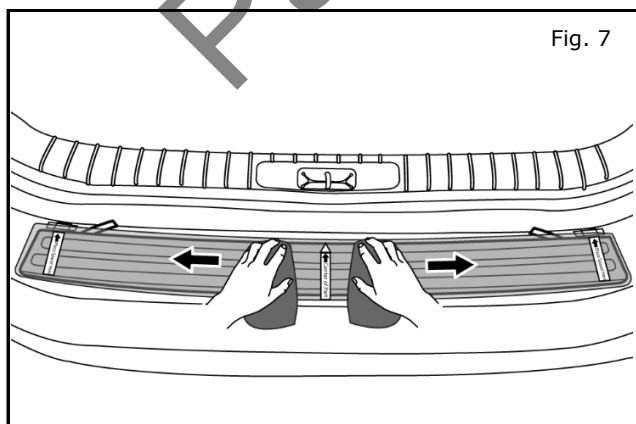
- 6) Prepare tape.
 - a) Remove part.
 - b) Peel back approximately 30mm on all tape liners.
 - c) Fold back all liners.



- 7) Re-align part to vehicle and lightly tack ends of bumper protector to vehicle.
- 8) Confirm center arrow alignment to vehicle and tight-fit to spacers. If necessary, un-tack bumper protector and repeat.



- 9) While holding part in position, remove rear tape liners.



- 10) Using clean, lint-free cloth, start at center and apply 15 lbs/in² of pressure along tape path.
- 11) Remove spacer blocks.

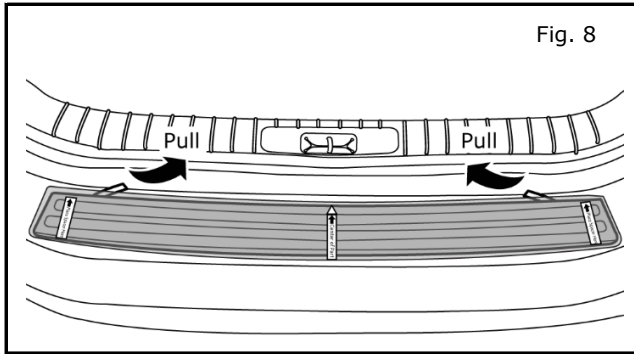

- 12) Remove front tape liners by pulling at a low angle.

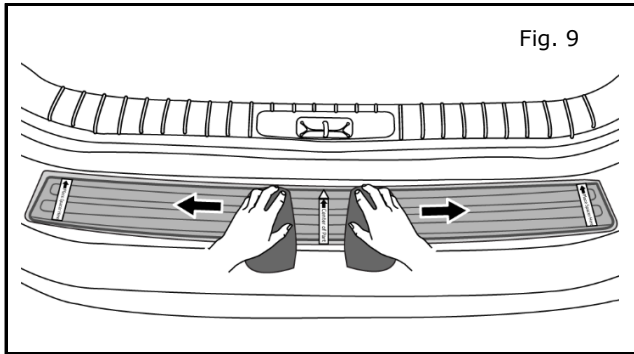

- 13) Using clean, lint-free cloth, start at center and apply 15 lbs/in of pressure along tape path.

- 14) To ensure adequate adhesion, re-apply 15 lbs/in² of pressure across entire part.

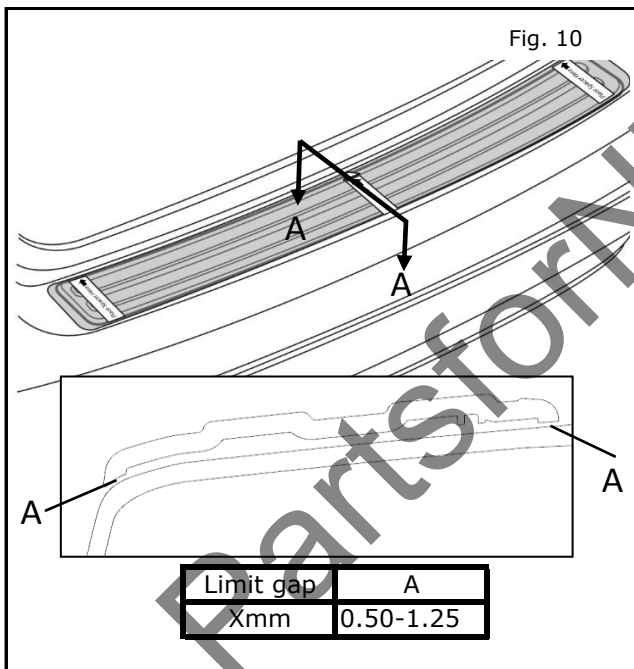

- 15) Gap to fascia around protector should match limit shown.

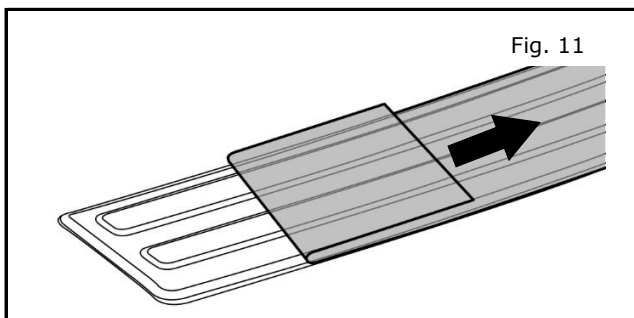

- 16) Remove protective film by pulling horizontally and discard.

- 17) Close rear hatch.

- 18) Do not expose vehicle to moisture for 24 hours.
