Installation time

Installation time, see table. This may vary depending on the condition of the car and its equipment package.

The installation time shown does not include any time spent on programming/coding.

The calculation of the total costs for the programming time must be factored into the calculation of retrofitting costs (must not be invoiced under the warranty).

Important information

 For the G30, the carbon front attachment **AC** may only be installed on the car with a carbon rear spoiler **DA** or carbon Pro rear spoiler **EA** (see EPC for details and part numbers).

For the G30 LCI, the carbon rear spoiler **DA** may only be installed on the car with a carbon front attachment **AC** or centre air guide (see EPC for information and part numbers).

For the G30, the carbon Pro rear spoiler **EA** may only be installed on the car with a carbon front attachment **AC** and with the air guide (see EPC for information and part numbers).

For the F90 LCI, the carbon Pro rear spoiler **EA** may only be installed on the car with a carbon front attachment **A**, **B** and **C** (see EPC for information and part numbers). ◀

The carbon rear diffuser **IA** **cannot** be installed on cars with trailer tow hitch (**SA 3AC**). The installation of the carbon rear diffuser **IA** on cars with Comfort Access (**SA 322**) results in the "Smart Opener" function of this option being no longer available which means that it can no longer be used.

After installing the carbon rear diffuser retrofit kit **IA** and the right/left carbon front attachment retrofit kit **AA'**, **AB'** and carbon front attachment **AC** on 550i and 550d (G30, G31 LCI MPA) cars, the retrofit must be programmed/coded via the – **Retrofits** – path.

These installation instructions are primarily designed for use within the BMW dealership organisation and by authorised BMW service companies.

These installation instructions are intended for use by qualified specialist staff trained on BMW cars with the relevant expert knowledge.

All work must be completed using the latest BMW repair manuals, wiring diagrams, servicing manuals and work instructions, in a logical order, using the prescribed tools (special tools), and observing current health and safety regulations.

If you experience installation or functional problems, restrict troubleshooting to approx. 0.5 hours for mechanical work and 1.0 hours for electrical work.

To avoid unnecessary extra work and/or costs, send an inquiry to the technical parts support team.

Quote the following information:

- VIN,
- retrofit kit part number,
- a detailed description of the problem,
- any work already carried out.

Do not archive the printout of these installation instructions. The current version can be found in the EPC.

Installation information

- All contact/bonding surfaces on the components being installed must be absolutely dry, clean, and free of wax, silicone and grease. These surfaces must be treated with suitable BMW cleaner or BMW primer (see EPC for details), as set out in the appropriate product application instructions.
- If you use adhesive tape, it must be applied using a contact pressure of between 10 N/cm² and 50 N/cm².
- Take care not to damage the parts when opening the packaging.
- Check that all the parts fit accurately on the car before installing them.
- All the components and their bonding surfaces must be at room temperature for installation. The ideal relative humidity is 50 %. Different values will change the specified times.
- After completing the bonding and installation work, the car must remain stationary at room temperature for at least **12 hours**.
- If adhesives are used, the car may be driven after **24 hours**, and may be taken through a car wash after **48 hours**. The car must not be driven above a speed of $v_{\max} < 100$ km/h for 24-48 hours.
- The installed parts may become loose and fly off the car if you fail to wait for the full reaction time of the primer/adhesive. **Danger of accidents!**
- Installation is shown in some instances on one side of the car only; proceed in the same way on the other side.
- All illustrations show LHD (left-hand drive) cars; proceed in the same way on RHD (right-hand drive) cars.

Terminology used

Initial installation: The carbon front attachment **AC** is installed for the first time.

Re-installation (for example in the event of a repair): The appropriate carbon front attachment **AC** is reinstalled.

Painting instructions

Check that all the kit components fit accurately on the car before painting them. Primed kit components must be pre-treated appropriately before painting.

These installation instructions must be given to the painter to ensure that the painting work is completed correctly.

Follow the BMW painting instructions (see **ISTA/AIR No. 99 00 ...**).

Ordering instructions

The materials such as liquid adhesive, cleaner and activators are assigned to the relevant products in the EPC (see EPC for information and part numbers). If the EPC does not explicitly specify the materials, always use cleaner, adhesive and activator from the BMW product range.

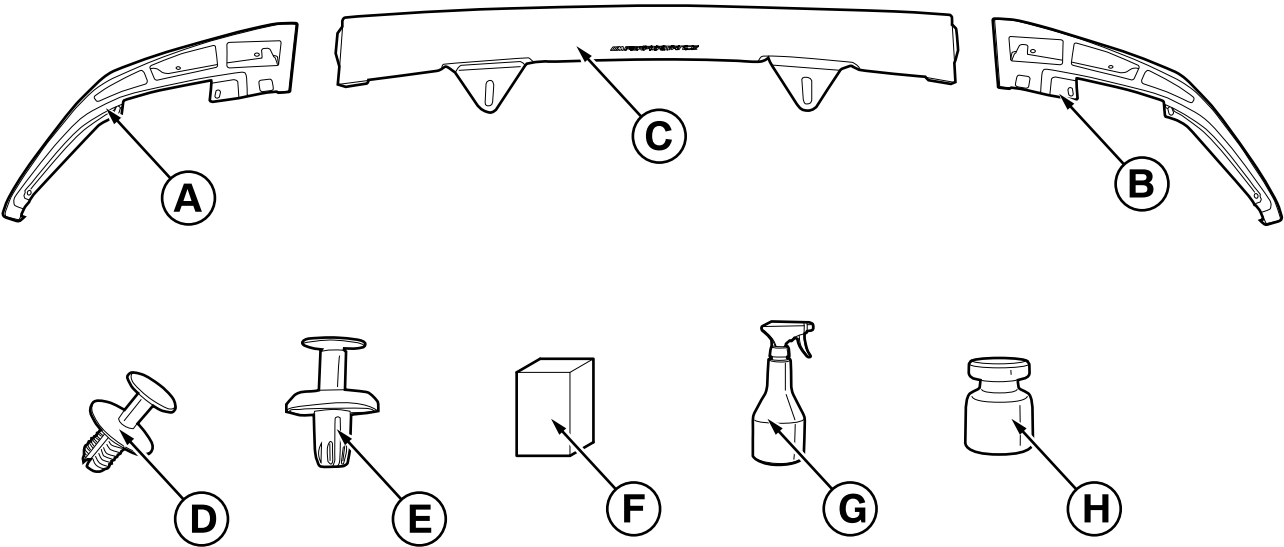


The installation of the carbon front attachment **AC** reduces the car's ground clearance and reduces the overhang angle at the front. Check the carbon front attachment **AC** at regular intervals for damage caused by collisions and, if it is damaged, have it replaced by trained personnel. ◀

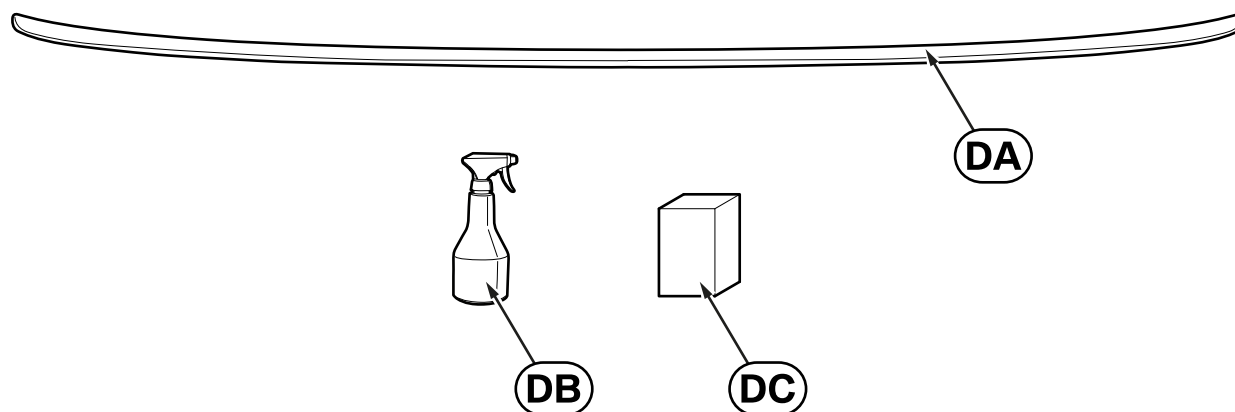

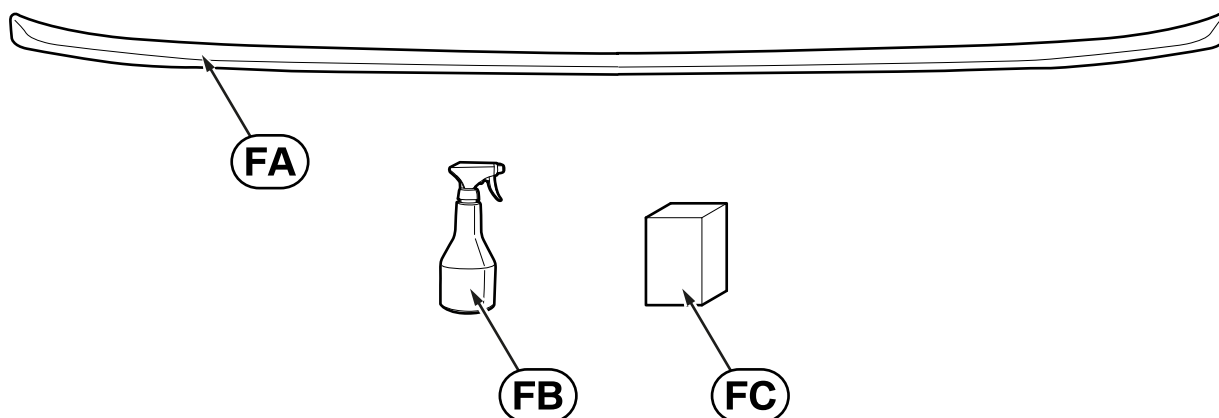

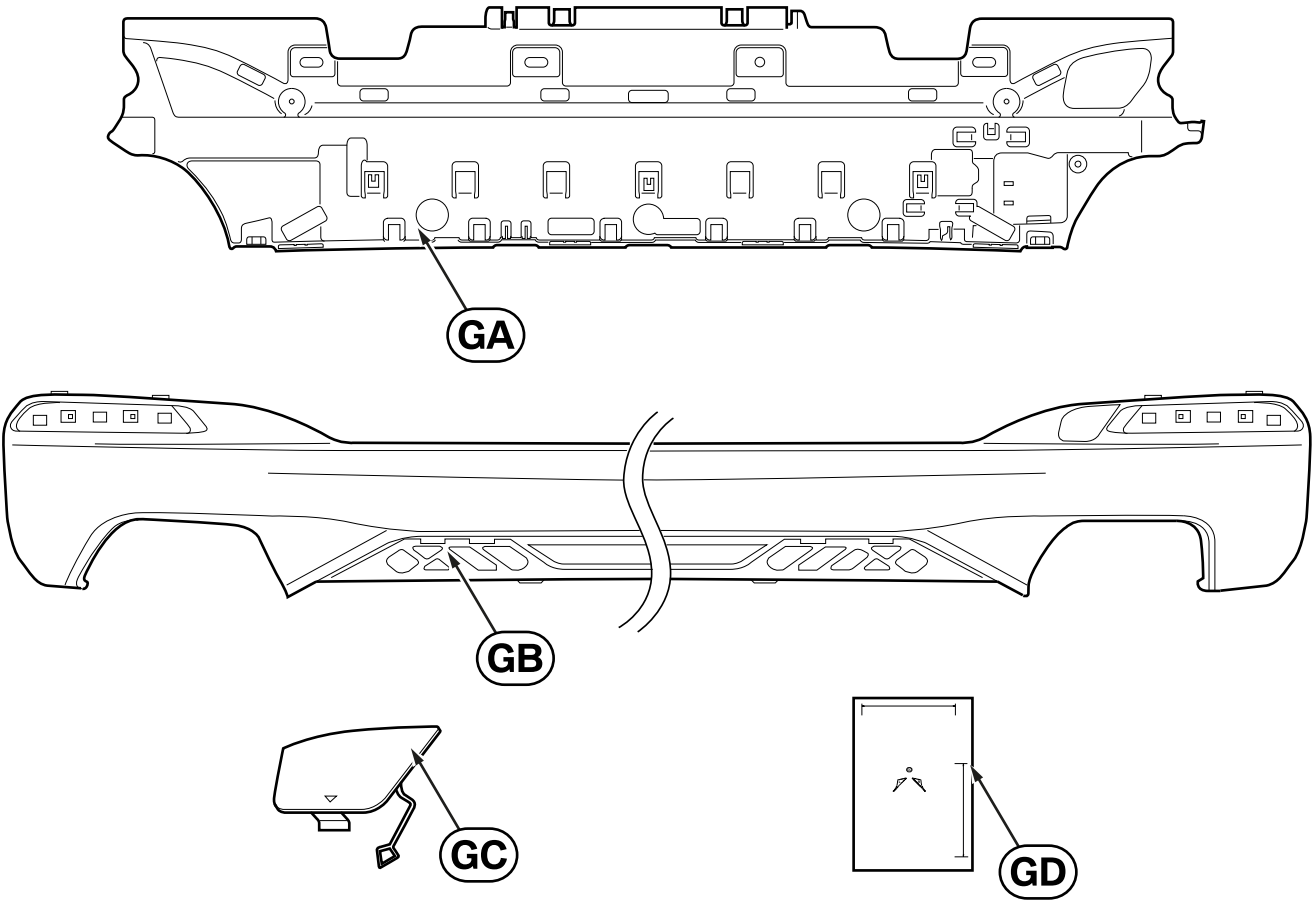

11. Installing the carbon front attachment F90 LCI

- All illustrations show the installation of the carbon right front attachment **A**.
Proceed in the same way to install the carbon left front attachment **B**. ◀



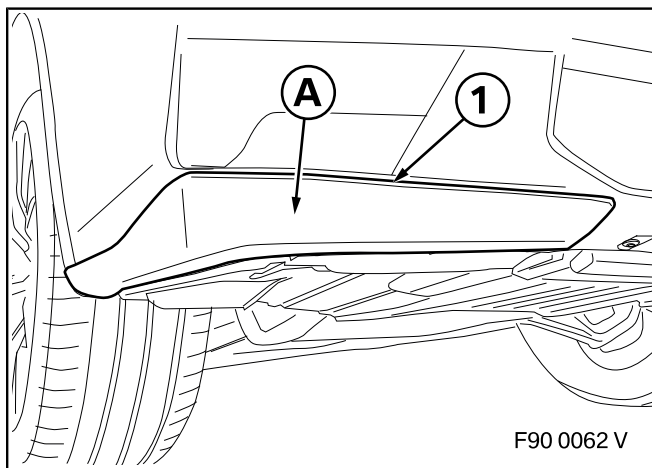
Remove the air guides (1) on both sides with the screws (2) and clips (3). They are no longer required.



- The bonding surfaces must be completely dry, clean, and free from wax or grease. ◀

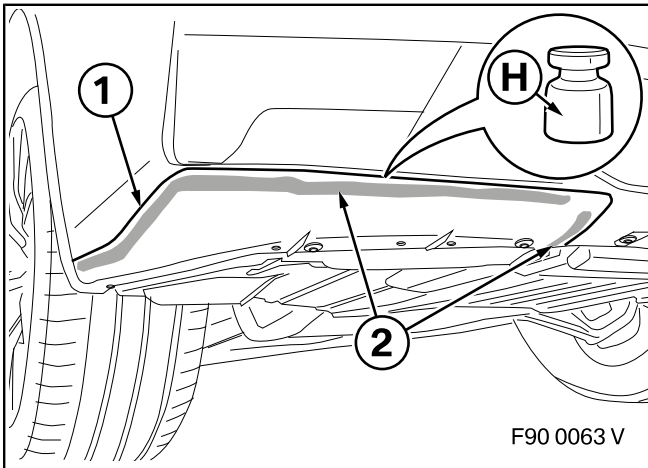
Remove the clips (1).

Clean the surface (2) of the car with cleaner **G** (not included in parts kit, see EPC further information).



Position carbon right front attachment **A** and mark the contour (1) on the front apron using suitable tools. Remove the carbon right front attachment **A**.

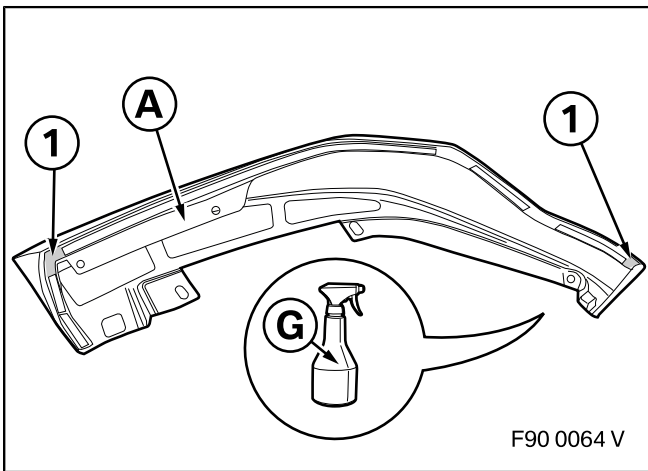
11. Installing the carbon front attachment F90 LCI



Wait until the drying time has elapsed. ◀

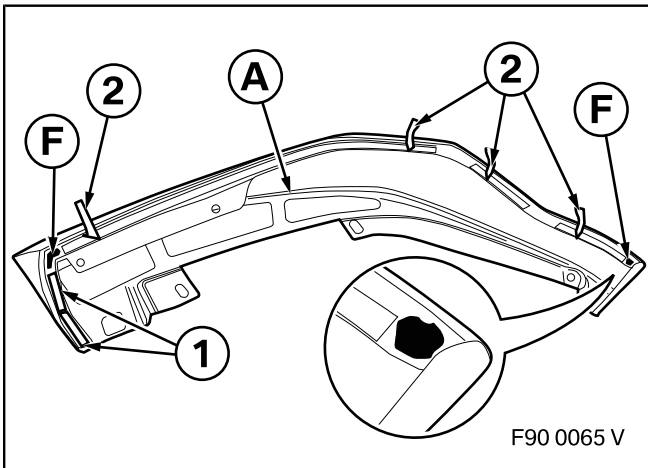
Prime the two surfaces (2) within the contour (1), as shown, with primer **H**. These surfaces are the contact points between the front apron and the adhesive tape on the front attachment.

Remove the contour (1) using suitable tools.



The bonding surfaces must be completely dry, clean, and free from wax or grease. ◀

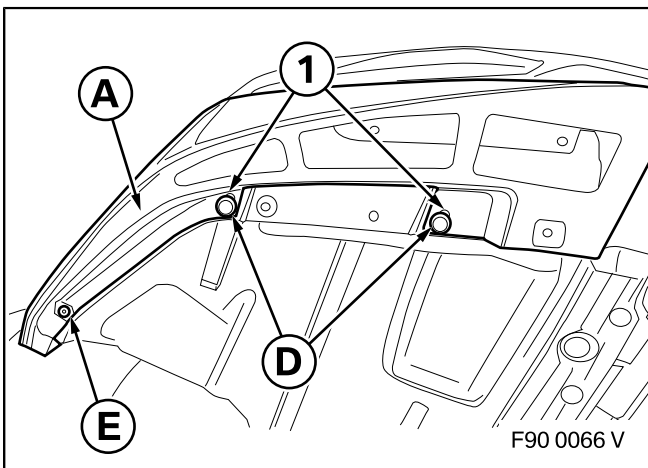
Abrade the surface (1) on the inside of the carbon right front attachment **A** using suitable tools and clean it with cleaner **G**.



Completely remove the backing films from the short adhesive strips (1).

Bend the ends of the backing films (2) to the outside.

Apply one dot of liquid adhesive **F** to the abraded surfaces.

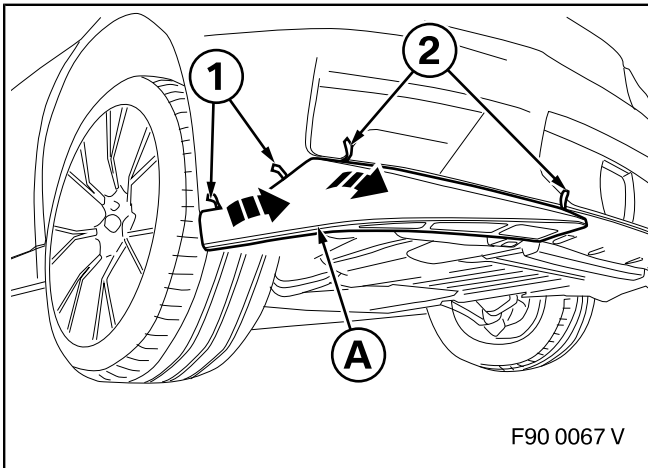


Remove any excess liquid adhesive **F** immediately.

Position the expanding rivet **D** at the rear end of the overall hole (1). ◀

Position the carbon right front attachment **A** and first push in the external expanding rivet **E**. Then position the carbon right front attachment **A** and push in the two expanding rivets **D**.

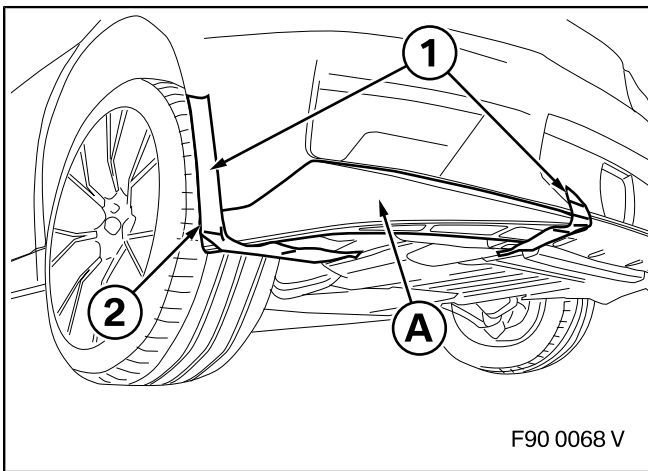
11. Installing the carbon front attachment F90 LCI



▶ Ensure that the gap is uniform. ◀

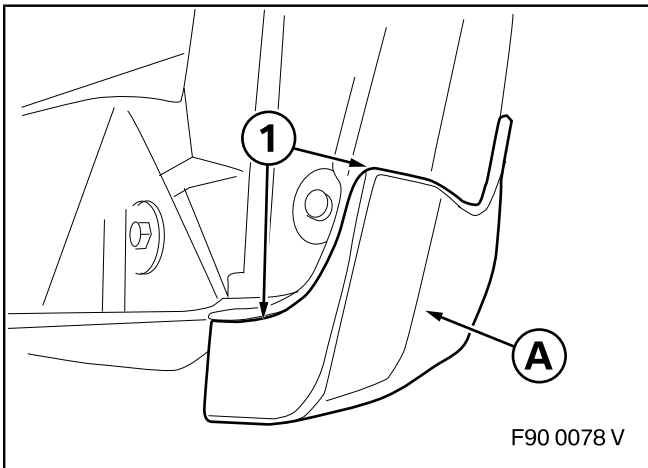
First pull out the film ends (1) and then (2) at an angle.

Press the carbon right front attachment **A** firmly onto the front apron several times.

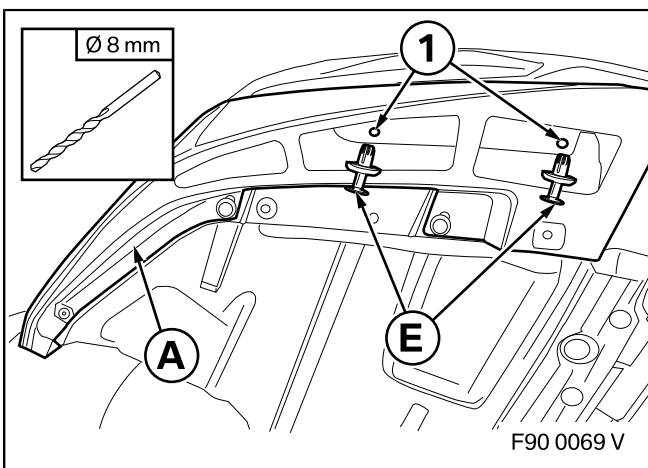

Secure the carbon right front attachment **A** with adhesive tapes (1) and a piece of foam (2) so that the gap is uniform.



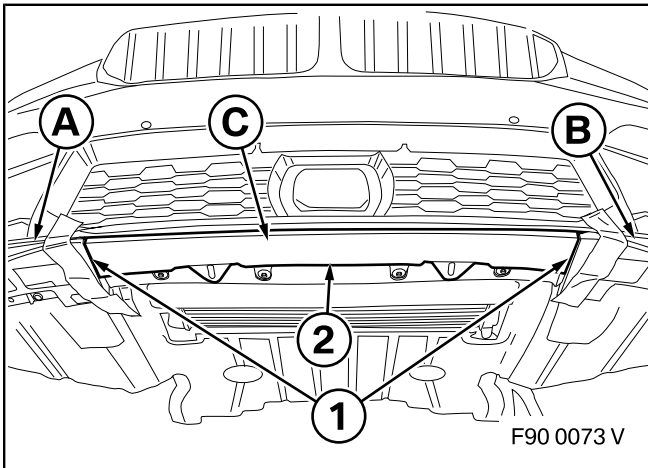
Use a clamp on the side of the carbon right front attachment **A** to ensure that it runs along the contour (1).



Drill the two holes (1) with a **diameter of 8 mm** through the front apron and press in the expanding rivet **E**.

▶ Repeat the whole installation procedure for the carbon left front attachment **B**. ◀

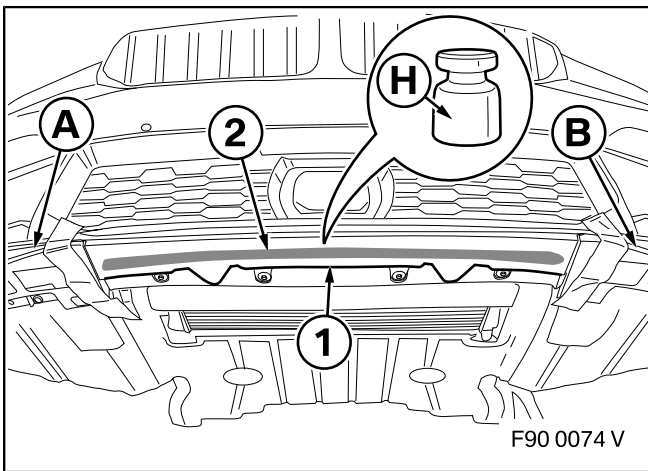
11. Installing the carbon front attachment F90 LCI



Push the carbon centre front attachment **C** between the two front attachments **A** and **B** and ensure that the gap is uniform (1) on both sides.

Mark the contour (2) (the internal edge) on the front apron using suitable tools.

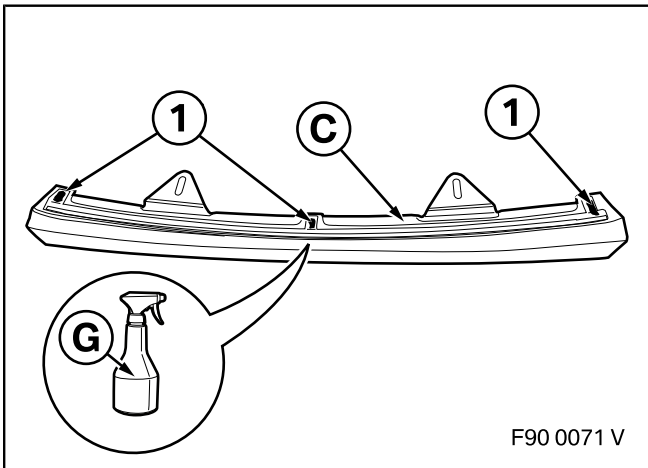
Remove the carbon centre front attachment **C**.



Wait until the drying time has elapsed. ◀

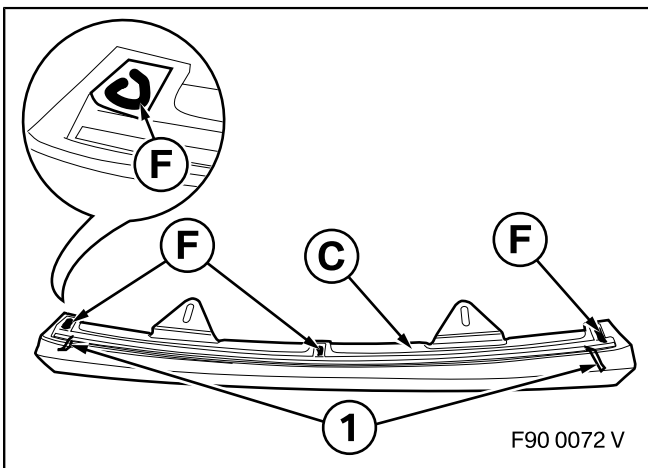
Prime the surface (2) within the contour (1), as shown, with primer **H**. These surfaces are the contact points between the front apron and the adhesive tape on the front attachment.

Remove the contour (1) using suitable tools.



The bonding surfaces must be completely dry, clean, and free from wax or grease. ◀

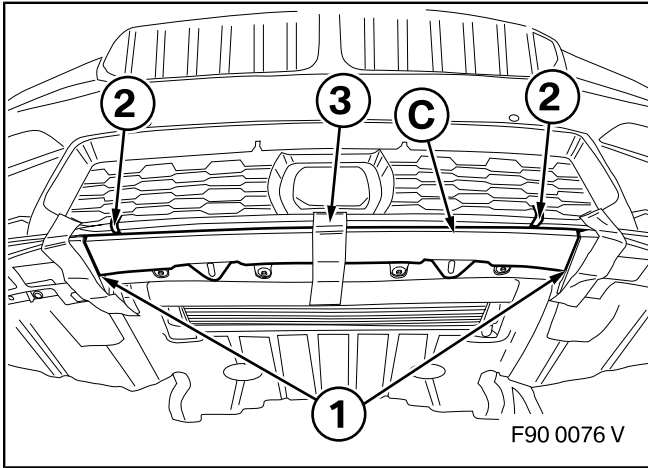
Abrade the three small surfaces (1) on the inside of carbon centre front attachment **C** using suitable tools and clean it with cleaner **G**.



Bend the ends of the backing film (1) to the outside.

Apply one dot of liquid adhesive **F** to the abraded surfaces.

11. Installing the carbon front attachment F90 LCI



- ▶ Carefully insert the front attachment between the two side sections. Ensure that no liquid adhesive is left on the front apron. Positioning: Position the centre front attachment **C** in the centre between the two side sections. Ensure it is flush with the front edge. ◀

Position the carbon centre front attachment **C** so that the gap (1) is uniform on both sides.

Pull out the two ends of the backing foil (2) at an angle.

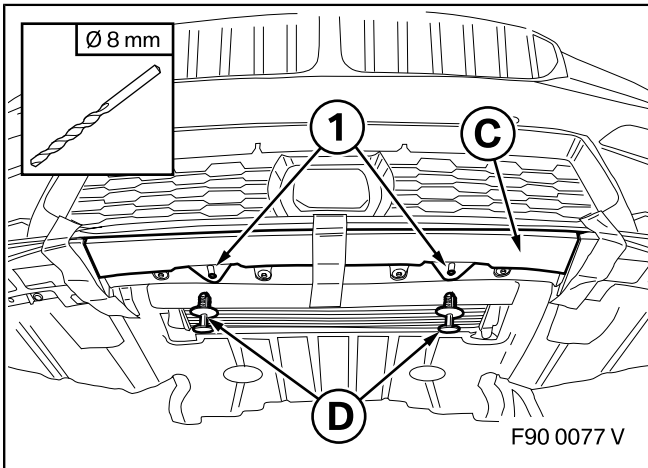
Apply firm pressure to all bonding surfaces on the inside from below (not shown).

Secure the carbon centre front attachment **C** with adhesive tape (3) and a foam piece if necessary so that the gap is uniform.

- ▶ Drill the two holes (1) in the oval holes as far to the rear as possible. ◀

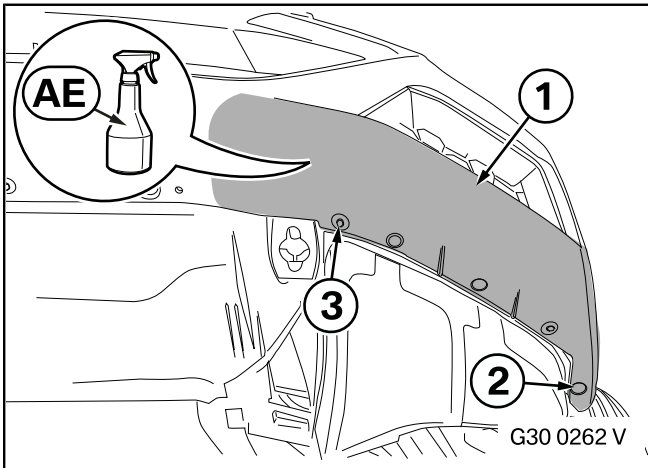
Drill the two holes (1) with a **diameter of 8 mm** through the front apron and press in the expanding rivet **D**.

12. Installing the carbon front attachment G30 LCI, G31 LCI

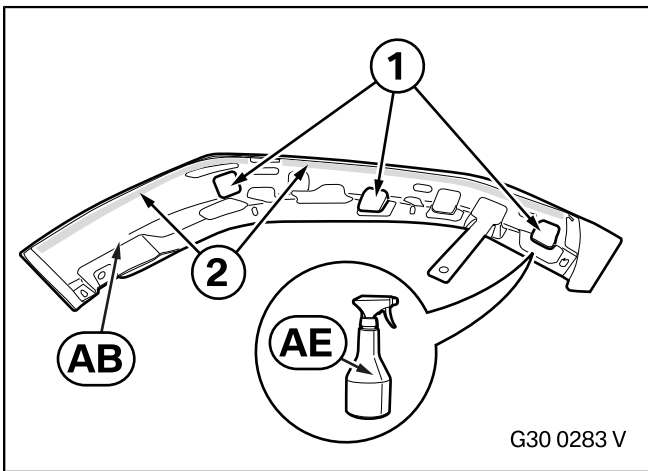

Clean the surface (1) of the car with cleaner **AE** (not included in parts kit, see EPC further information).

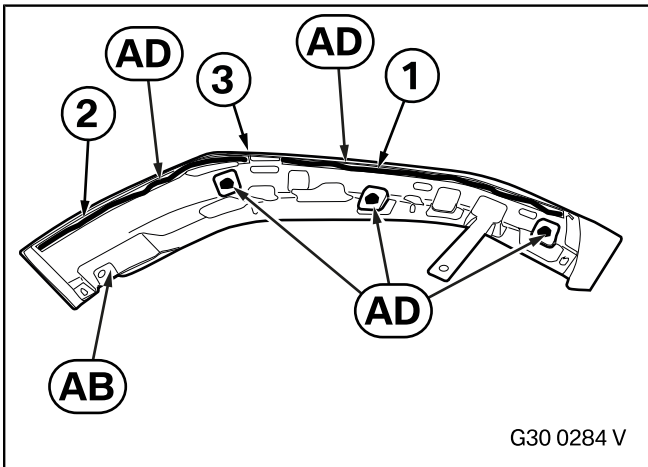
Remove the clip (2) and screw (3).



- ☐ The bonding surfaces must be completely dry, clean, and free from wax or grease.

Wait until the drying time has elapsed. ◀

Abrade the small surfaces (1) on the inside of the carbon left front attachment **AB** and the surfaces (2) using suitable tools and clean them with cleaner **AE**.

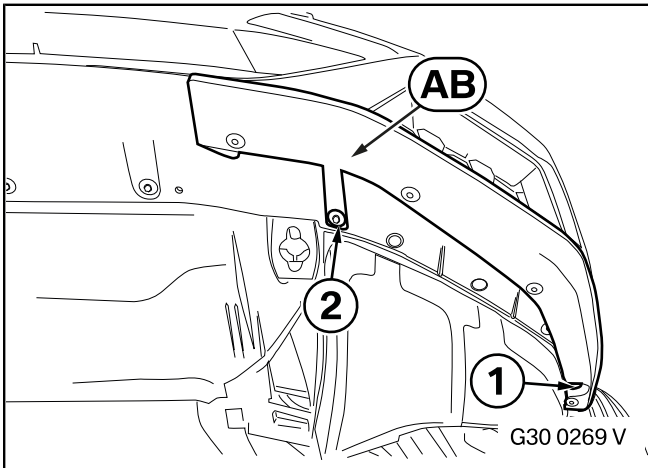


Apply one dot of liquid adhesive **AD** to the surfaces you abraded earlier.

Also apply the liquid adhesive **AD** to surfaces (1) and (2) over their full length. Start at the edge of the PU substructure and apply it right into the radius (3) as shown.

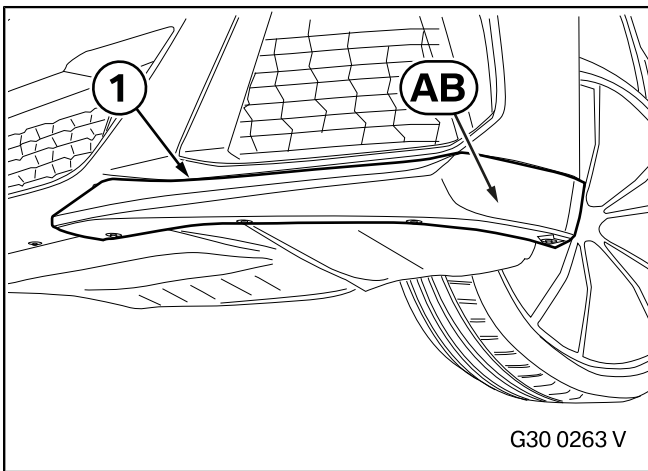
Within the radius (between **AD** and (3)), ensure that sufficient liquid adhesive is applied to the carbon shell so that it can bond firmly direct to the bumper trim.

12. Installing the carbon front attachment G30 LCI, G31 LCI



Remove any excess liquid adhesive **AD** immediately. ◀

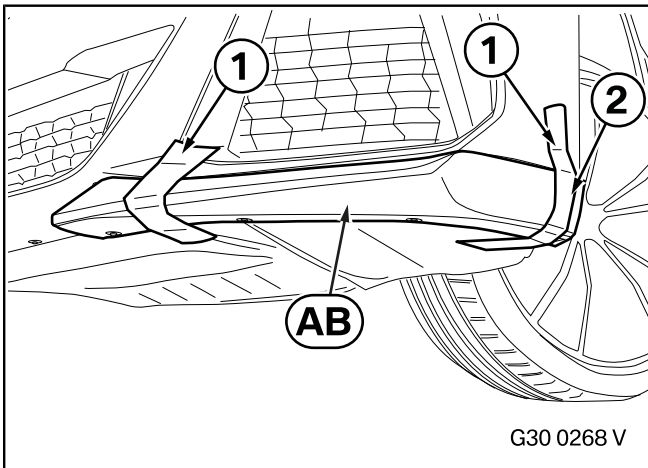
Position the carbon left front attachment **AB** and push in the existing expanding rivet (1). Then tighten the existing screw (2).



Ensure that the gap (1) is uniform. ◀

Press the carbon left front attachment **AB** firmly onto the front apron several times.

Remove any excess liquid adhesive immediately using suitable tools. ◀

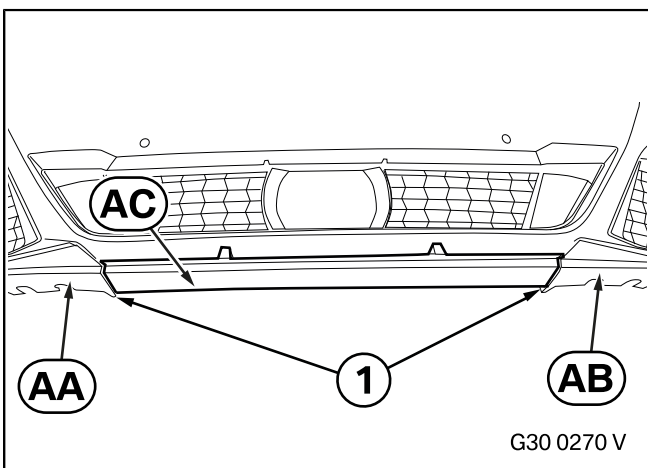


Secure the carbon left front attachment **AB** with strips of adhesive tape (1) and a piece of foam (2) so that the gap is uniform. It is possible that more than the two pieces of adhesive tape/foam may be required.

Ensure that the various adhesion points on the underside of the front apron are correctly positioned. If necessary, secure them with adhesive tape, including towards the underbody.

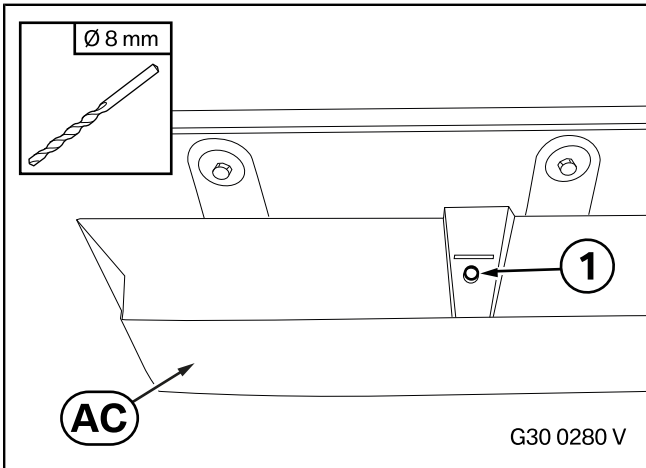

Push the carbon centre front attachment **AC** between the two front attachments **AA** and **AB** and ensure that the gap is uniform (1) on both sides.

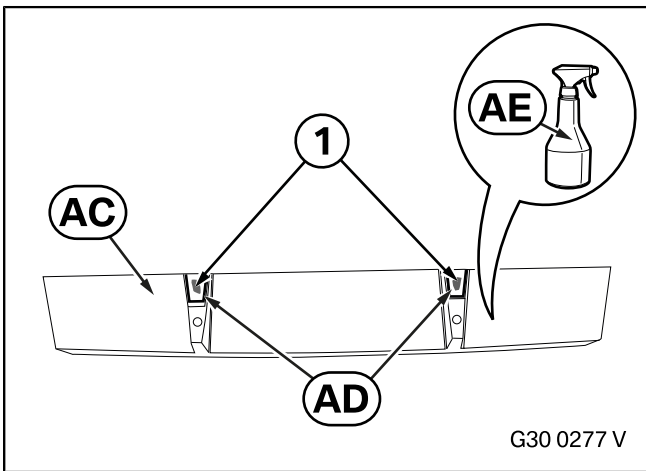
12. Installing the carbon front attachment G30 LCI, G31 LCI

Remove the carbon centre front attachment **AC**.

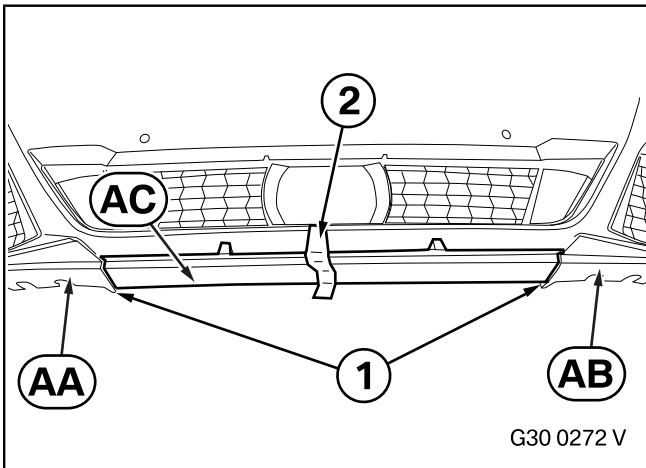
Then drill the two holes (1) with a **diameter of 8 mm** through the front apron.



▶ The bonding surfaces must be completely dry, clean, and free from wax or grease. ◀

Abrade the small surfaces (1) on the carbon centre front attachment **AC** using suitable tools and clean it with cleaner **AE**.

Apply a large dot of liquid adhesive **AD** to the abraded surfaces.

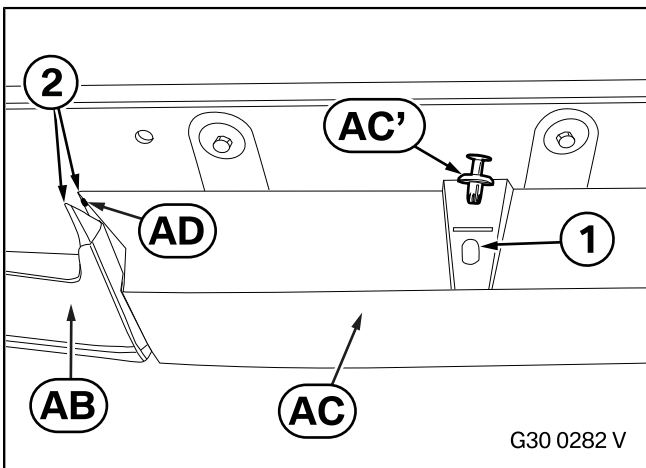


▶ Remove any excess liquid adhesive **AD** immediately. ◀

Position the carbon centre front attachment **AC** so that the gap (1) is uniform on the both sides.

Secure the carbon centre front attachment **AC** with adhesive tape (2) and a foam piece if necessary so that the gap is uniform.

▶ If necessary, adjust the carbon front attachments **AA** and **AB** slightly. Then recheck and clean all the joints. ◀



Push the two expanding rivets **AC'** into the two boreholes (1).

Then glue the carbon centre front attachment **AC** to the carbon front attachment **AB** flush at the corners (2) using a dot of liquid adhesive **AD**. Fix the corners (2) temporarily using suitable equipment (clips for adhesive tape).

Repeat this process with the carbon front attachment **AA**.

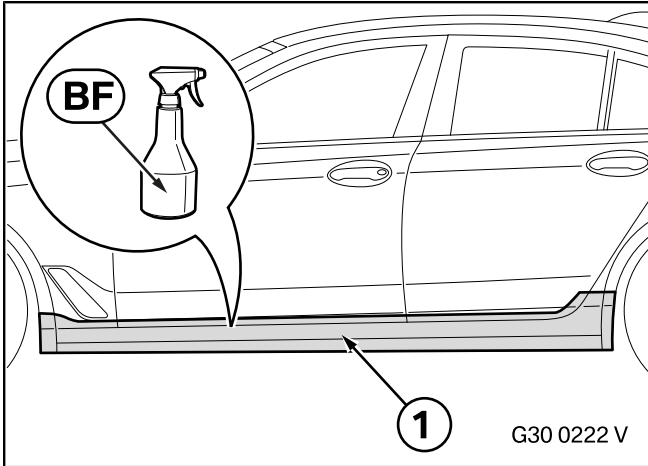

13. Installing the matt black side skirt attachment G30 LCI, G31 LCI and carbon side skirt attachment F90 LCI

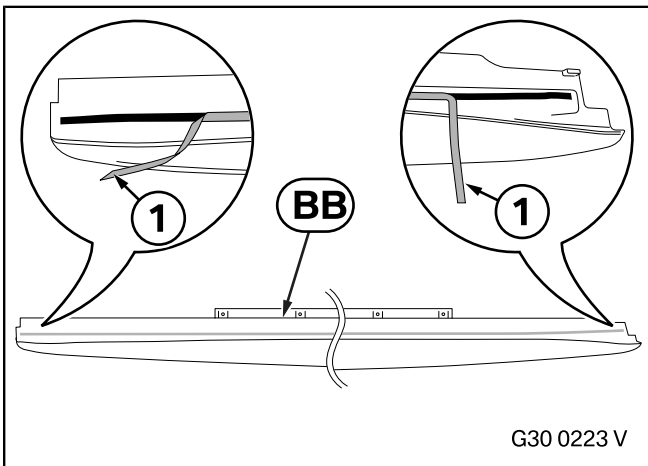
- ▷ All illustrations show the installation of the matt black left side skirt attachment **AB**.
Use the same procedure to install the matt black right side skirt attachment **BA**, carbon right side skirt attachment **BA'** and carbon left side skirt attachment **BB'**. ◀
- ▷ Please note that if you are also installing the side skirt film, it must be affixed to the car before you install the matt black side skirt attachment **BA** and **BB**, and the carbon side skirt attachment **BA'** and **BB'**.

Complete the installation work as described in installation instructions No. **01 29 2 298 023**. ◀

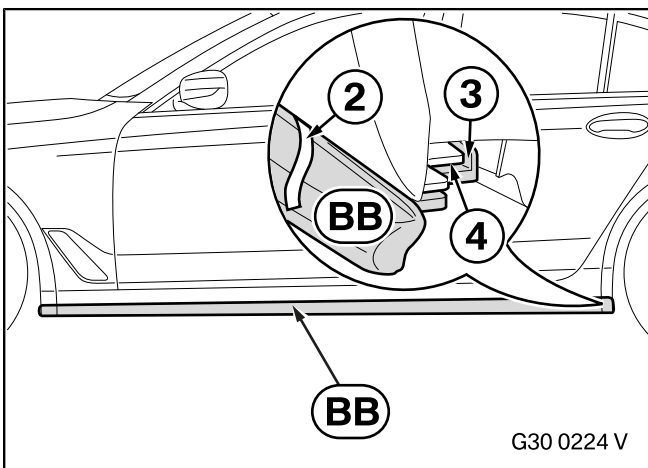


- ▷ The bonding surfaces must be completely dry, clean, and free from wax or grease. ◀

Clean the surface (1) of the car with cleaner **BF** (not included in the parts kit, see EPC for further details).



Release a little of the backing film (2) on both sides of the matt black left side skirt attachment **BB**.

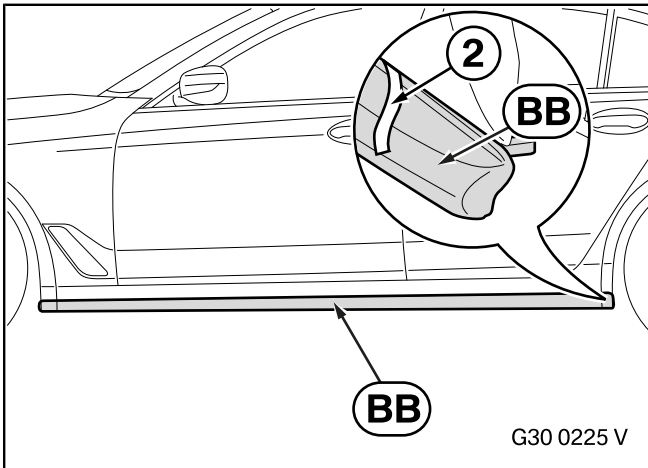


- ▷ Ensure that the released ends of the adhesive backing film (2) are visible. ◀

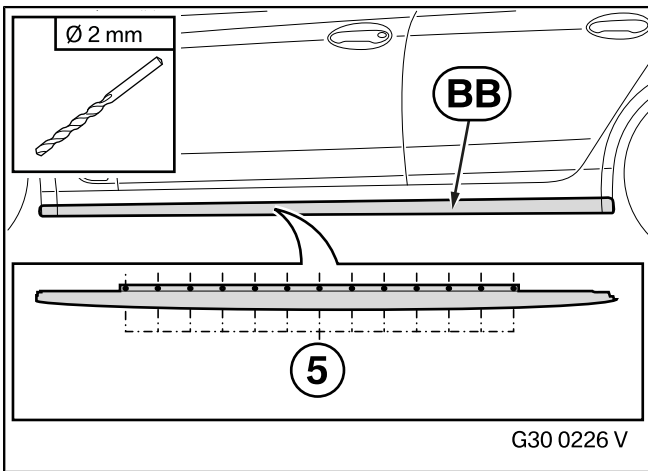
Position the matt black left side skirt attachment **BB** so that the stop (3) is behind the car edge (4).

Centre the matt black left side skirt attachment **BB**.

13. Installing the matt black side skirt attachment G30 LCI, G31 LCI and carbon side skirt attachment F90 LCI

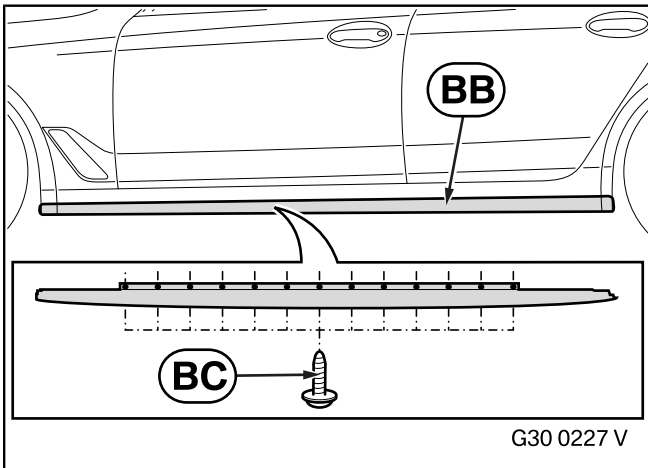


Carefully remove the backing film (2) from outside to inside and firmly press the matt black left side skirt attachment **BB** into position.

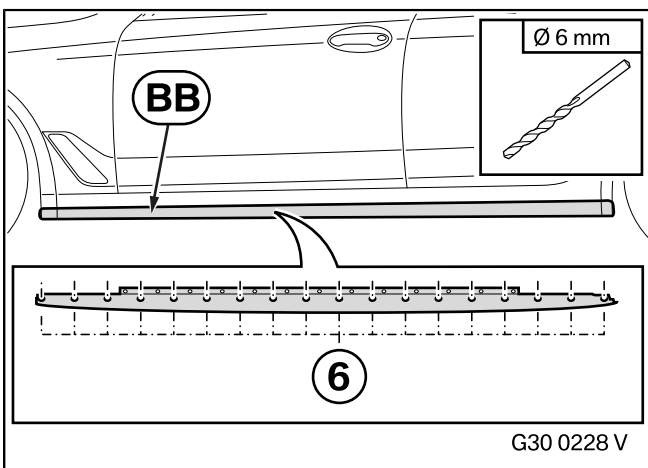


▶ When drilling down to the drill depth, take care not to damage parts underneath. ◀

Use a Ø 2 mm drill bit to mark the 13 holes (5) in the matt black left side skirt attachment **BB** on the side skirt.

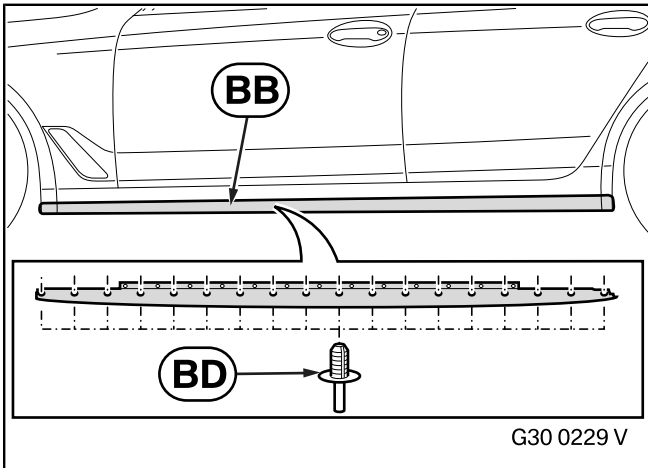

Use a Ø 6 mm drill bit to drill through the 18 hole marks (6) in the matt black left side skirt attachment **BB** and transfer them to the side skirt.

For carbon side skirt attachment F90 LCI only:

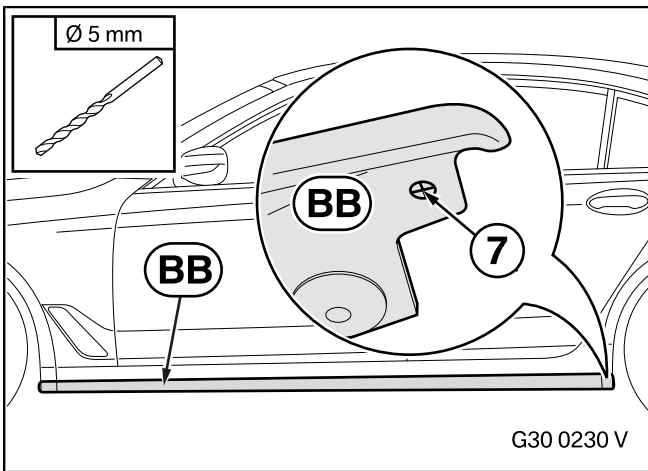
Use a Ø 6 mm drill bit to drill the 18 holes (6) in the side skirt.

13. Installing the matt black side skirt attachment G30 LCI, G31 LCI and carbon side skirt attachment F90 LCI



Install the matt black left side skirt attachment **BB** using expanding rivets **BD**.

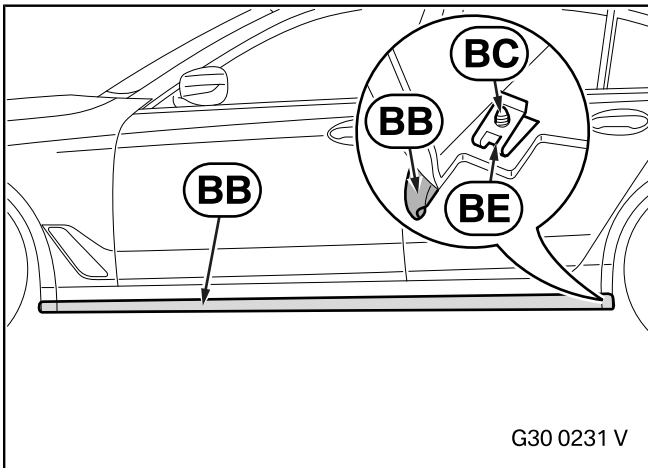
Release the rear wheel arch trim a little.

Secure the carbon Pro rear spoiler **EA** with adhesive tape (8) first in the centre and then on the outside. Do not remove the adhesive tape (8) for at least 6 hours.

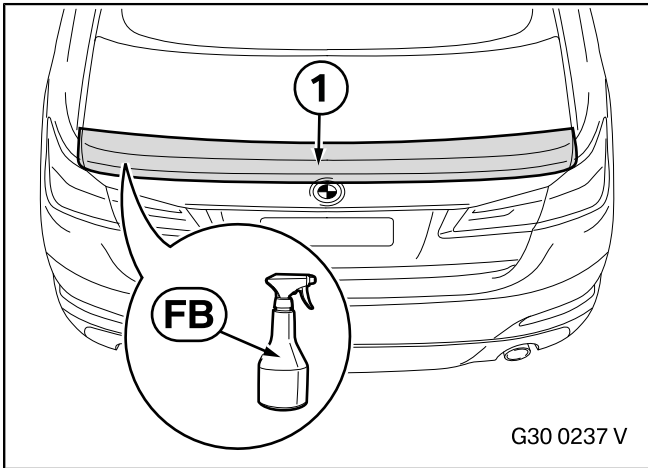

Cut the large underfloor trim **II** along the cutting edge (7) using a suitable tool.

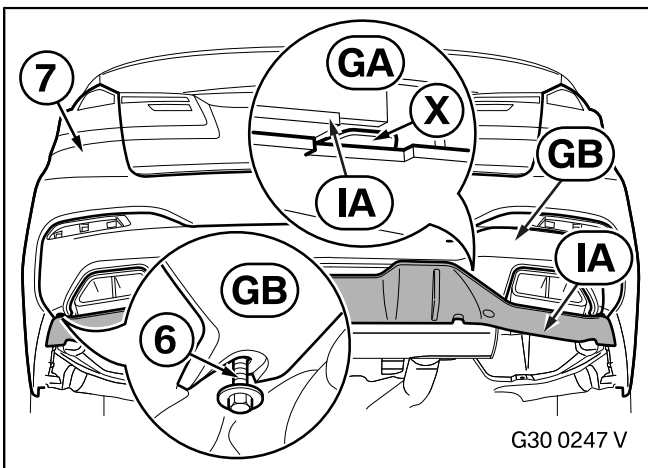

Fit the assembly of the black high gloss bumper cover **GB** and matt black rear diffuser **JA** into the rear trim (5) so that the four lugs **X** on the black high gloss bumper cover **GB** are fully inserted in the exhaust system support adapter cover **GA**.

The black high gloss bumper cover **GB** and matt black rear diffuser **JA** must be under the small underfloor trim **I**.



- Ensure that the four lugs **X** inserted in the exhaust system support adapter cover **GA** do not slip out during the remainder of the installation work. ◀

- The fastening points (6) are only to be installed on cars without a trailer tow hitch (SA 3AC). ◀

Install the assembly of the black high gloss bumper cover **GB** and matt black rear diffuser **JA** using hexagon screws **JC** and hexagon screws (7) from the standard component.

Install the rear reflector from the standard component as described in **ISTA/AIR**.

20. Concluding work and coding

The retrofit system requires programming/coding for all cars if the carbon rear diffuser retrofit kit **IA** is installed.

The retrofit system requires programming/coding for 550i and 550d cars if the carbon left/right front attachment retrofit kit **AA, AB** and the carbon front attachment retrofit kit **AC** are installed.

- If necessary, carry out a vehicle test using the ISTA system, and note, or work through, any errors that have been recorded
- Conduct a function test
- Re-assemble the car
